### BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN TRAILS

The Town of Troy borders the lower St. Croix National Scenic Riverway to the west, and is one of the western-most townships in St. Croix County, Wisconsin. Troy is located between the historic and vibrant cities of Hudson and River Falls.

Residents and visitors can enjoy the rural landscape in local parks, which complement the town's rich agricultural tradition. Recreation in the town of Troy provides safe and active outdoor opportunities for the diverse population. Town's Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan 2000-05 is available on town's website.

Park areas include Cove Boat Ramp, Glover Park, Pemble's Access, and marked bike and pedestrian trails along designated town roads. The town Park Rangers and St. Croix County Sheriff's Dept. patrol the parks on a regular basis. Violators may be ticketed.

## **COVE BOAT RAMP**

**306A Cove Rd., Hudson**

**SEASON:** daily, year-round

**HOURS:** 6am – 9:30pm

- Concrete launch ramp
- Dock and gangway
- Winter use by foot, ATV, or snowmobile across ramp only

Cove Boat Ramp was upgraded and renovated in 2004 with improved access for boaters to the St. Croix River. Informational bulletins, describing permit rates and rules/regulations, and Annual Permit

stickers are available at both the Town Hall and Recycling Center during regular business hours. The ramp area is routinely patrolled, and violators will be ticketed.



## **GLOVER PARK**

**428 N. Glover Rd., Hudson**

**SEASON:** daily, year-round

**HOURS:** 8am – ½ hour after sunset

- Modern restrooms with hand washing sinks and baby changing stations
- East and West Pavilion (kitchen)
- Water fountain (auto & hand pump)
- Water bottle filler between restrooms
- Trail system, 2.5 miles (marked)
- North and South Ball Fields
- Native prairie gardens & remnant
- Pickleball court (in progress)
- Ample parking and bike racks

## **Playground**



Play events include track ride, space net, swings, horizontal and vertical climber, digger, and slide with a sand surface. Accessibility for individuals with disabilities includes a rubberized surface to play
